Dear Parents and Carers

As we approach half term I am pleased to report that the first half of the autumn term has been a busy one at Stowford School. Children have been on visits, including the Year 6 residential at Beam House, and enjoyed curricular and extracurricular activities.

#### Parents' Evenings:

It has been lovely to see so many parents attending Parents' Evenings. We are very happy that you are all so engaged with school.

Please remember that if there is anything that worries you or you would like to discuss a matter at any time, you do not need to wait for Parents' Evening. Any adult in school would be happy to make time for you to address any concerns or answer your queries, and I am available to talk to at the school gate as regularly as possible.

#### Harvest Festival:



As you will be aware, there was a special Harvest Festival assembly for the children in school today.

Thank you for all the donations that were so generously provided for our Harvest Table. All donations have been given to Ivybridge Foodbank. Representatives from the Foodbank joined us for the assembly, and took your donations straight to the Foodbank with them afterwards. They were really quite overwhelmed at the generosity of the Stowford community. **Thank you for your support as always**.

#### Attendance:

In order to raise the profile of good attendance, we are now running a weekly competition. #### Defibrillator:

I am very pleased to let you know that we have a defibrillator. This is to be installed by the front door of the school so that it is accessible to the wider community in case a need arises.

#### Year 1 Wild Tribe:

We would like to notify parents of children in Year 1 that there is to be a change in Wild Tribe provision. Year 1 children will now join the rest of the school in enjoying Wild Tribe sessions across three full days per year, rather than just one hour per week. This provision will take place on-site in the yurt and fire pit area. The previous arrangement of one hour a week did not give sufficient time to give the quality of provision that we wanted.

Class teachers will advise their classes via Dojo when these days will be held.

#### Uniform:

Thank you to all parents for ensuring that children are attending school in smart uniform, including long hair being tied back, with varnishfree nails and no jewellery!

Please remember that the pale blue Stowford polo shirt has been phased out and replaced with the navy blue logo'd version. Please do not purchase non-logo'd navy blue shirts. A reminder also that earrings should be small, round studs only, not shapes such as stars, moons, butterflies etc. This is for safety reasons.

#### PE Kit:

Thank you also for ensuring that children attend school in smart PE kit on the correct days for their class. Please note that the PE kit requirement is a white or navy blue t-shirt (with or without school logo) but not with football stripes, Adidas, Nike or other brand markings, etc. The top must be a t-shirt - without collar or buttons - for health and safety reasons. PE days are not mufti days. The school jumper must be worn to school so that children are smart for assemblies and when sitting learning in the classroom, etc. In addition, children can bring a separate top (dark plain hoody/fleece) to wear during outdoor PE sessions, but this is not to be worn in the classroom.

Smart dress makes a huge difference to focus in class and helps us all to concentrate on the important things in school.

#### School Lunches:

A polite reminder to ALL Year Groups (including those in receipt of UIFSM) - **please ensure that lunches are <u>pre-ordered</u> via ParentPay**. Please contact the school office if you require any help with this.

#### Nasal Flu Immunisation

This year children will again be offered a free nasal flu vaccination in school. The link to give consent for your child/children to receive the immunisation was sent out via email on Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> October. The closing date for submission of consent forms is by midday on Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> November. The immunisations will take place on Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> November in school.

#### Applications for Secondary School

This is a reminder to all parents and carers of Year 6 children that the closing date for applications to secondary school is 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023. The easiest way to apply is online by visiting <u>www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline</u> If you require support with this process, please call into the school office before the end of the week. Devon have advised that there is high demand for places at secondary schools this year so please do not miss the deadline!

#### Year 3/4 playground:

We would appreciate it hugely if parents/carers could help us to stop the children using the playtime equipment before school in the Y3/4 playground. This is a very small and busy area, and we do not want anyone to be hurt by flying equipment. We would also appreciate it if you could help us by dissuading children from sitting on top of the traversing wall for health and safety reasons. They are not allowed to do this during school time. Thank you for your support.

#### School Texting Service:

For your information, texts from the school are sent to 'Contact 1' on your child/ren's contacts list <u>only</u>. Please ensure that Contact 1 is aware that they will need to cascade any information received via text to other family members themselves.

#### Staff Information:

We are very sad to be saying goodbye to Mrs Liz Langdon, a member of our dedicated premises staff. Mrs Langdon has been keeping the school spotless since 1994, but has decided it is now time to retire! We thank you sincerely for your hard work over the years!
