Children born between 1/9/2019 and 31/8/2020 are due to start school next September. You can apply online at [Citizen Portal - Sign in \(devon.gov.uk\)](https://www.devon.gov.uk/citizen-portal). Applications opened on 15th November 2023 and will close at midnight on 15th January 2024. If you cannot access the school admissions website, you can get more information by calling the Education Helpline on: 0345 155 1019 or email: admissions@devon.gov.uk.

Even if you have a child already at the school or in the nursery, you must apply for a place through the Admissions system. If you have a child who will start school in September 2024 and would like to come and look around, please contact the school office who will be happy to arrange this with you (Tel: 01752 894163). The Devon Schools Admission Service makes offers of places on Tuesday 16th April 2024.

Attendance:

Attendance continues to be a focus for Stowford School and the weekly class competition explained in the last newsletter is proving very popular with the children. Our current school attendance figure for school age children is 96% but the school target is 97%. The main factor reducing the school figures is unauthorised holidays. Attached with this newsletter is a reminder letter to advise all parents of the law regarding attendance at school. This letter serves as a formal warning, which is part of the legal process when absences are unauthorised. Sadly, we are aware of some cases where the school has been advised that an absence is due to ill health when in fact the absence has been due to a holiday. Where the school is aware of dishonesty it is possible for such absences to be unauthorised and referred to Devon for legal proceedings.

Vision Screening for pupils in Foundation:

A member of the Orthoptics team from Plymouth Royal Eye Infirmary will be visiting the school on **Monday 8th January 2024** to conduct vision screening. Parents/carers will already have received letters regarding this in order to give permission or opt out.

I am very pleased to let you know that the defibrillator installed at the school is now in service. Unfortunately, the previous box was faulty so a brand new replacement has now been installed. The defibrillator is by the front door of the school so that it is accessible to the wider community in case a need arises.

The application process is online via the Citizen Portal: [Citizen Portal - Sign in \(devon.gov.uk\)](#). It is worth registering if you are eligible as this attracts considerable extra funding for your child's education, even if your child does not actually have a school meal. Please also apply even if your child is in receipt of UIFSM, as the school will still receive additional funding which benefits your child and the school. Furthermore, this will entitle you to the holiday meals vouchers and activities as outlined above.
