
### Children's Mental Health Week:

## P-Bone [Trombone] Lessons at Ivybridge Community College:

For parents and carers of children in Years 4, 5 and 6.

A quick reminder of an exciting opportunity that the children have had (or will be having) in conjunction with ICC. A music tutor, Vincent Touret, has been visiting Stowford and has been teaching the children to play the 'P-Bone' (trombone).

Year 6 received P-Bone lessons in the Autumn Term, Year 5 are receiving lessons this term and Year 4 will be having their lessons in the summer term.

I am hoping that some children will have really enjoyed them, and, if so, would be interested in an opportunity to further this learning.

I am pleased to say that there is now a class for Stowford students who would like to continue to learn the trombone in a small group with Vincent. Classes will take place on Tuesdays after school from 4.00pm to 4.30pm in the Music department at ICC, starting on Tuesday,  $27^{th}$  February. It will run for fourteen sessions and the cost to parents will be £45.00 in total for all fourteen classes. The classes will be completely free for those children who are eligible for Free School Meals (but not for Service Pupil Premium).

ICC will provide instruments to use in the sessions so that the P-Bones can stay at Stowford. There will also be the opportunity for parents/carers to pay  $\pounds 25$  per term to be able to rent the instrument from DMEH so that it can be taken home in between the sessions for practice, but this is optional.
