Dear Parents and Carers of Puffins and Curlews Class

Spirit of Adventure, June 2024

This summer, the children in Year 4 will have the opportunity to take part in a forest expedition organised by Young Spirit (<http://www.youngspirit.co.uk/>). Each Year 4 class will spend one night away, accompanied by teaching and support staff from school and fully qualified and experienced leaders from Young Spirit. The expeditions will take place as follows:

Puffins: Monday 17th June - Tuesday 18th June 2024

Curlews: Tuesday 18th June - Wednesday 19th June 2024

This two day, one night forest expedition is a gentle introduction to wild living and takes place at the Young Spirit site in Dartmouth, providing a wonderful opportunity to explore the Dart estuary between Dittisham and Dartmouth. The children will spend one night camping close to the river on the stunning Raleigh Estate, with a private creek, river frontage and acres of fields and woodland.

Transport has been organised by the school to and from Hole Farm in Dartmouth. The group will leave school at 9.15am on Day 1 so that they arrive at the starting point for the trek to the campsite by 10.30am. During their experience, they will take part in a range of activities including trekking, cooking, bush craft and a night walk. They will be back at school around 2.30/2.45pm the following day for collection by parents/carers if possible. The school office will be in contact with the group on Day 2 and will send a text to parents/carers in the afternoon with a more accurate return time.

The cost of the expedition, including transport, will be **£86 per child** and payment can be made in two instalments: £43.00 by the end of April and £43.00 by the end of May 2024 so that payment is completed by the date of the visit. A text reminder will be sent when the payments are due. If you have any concerns about paying for the cost of the visit, please see your child's class teacher in confidence. The cost will be £43.00 for children currently in receipt of Free School Meals.

If you would like your child to take part in the visit, please complete and return the slip below. There is also a box to tick if you do not want your child to take part. Payment for this visit should be made online via ParentPay - please ask at the school office if you require help with this.

Additional Information:

- The children will need a packed lunch on day one. If your child is in receipt of free school meals this will be provided by the school at your request. (Please advise the school office as soon as possible so you can be issued with an order form).
- On the day of departure the children will need to come to school in the clothes that they will be wearing for that day (**see kit list**).
- They will need a rucksack with carrying items - including a packed lunch for the first day (**see kit list**).
- Their bedding, overnight and camping kit (**see kit list**) will need to be in double (2) black bin bags which are tied and labelled, plus an extra spare bin bag inside in case one rips.
- They will leave school at 9:15am and return to school around 2.30pm on the following day. A text will advise of a more accurate time on the day (if possible). Children should be collected by parents/carers at this time if possible please. If you arrange for a different parent/carer to collect your child please ensure you have informed the school office.
- No electronic items such as mobile phones, iPads etc. are to be taken.
- They may take one packet of sweets for sharing around the campfire.
- They will come back very tired and smelly!
