A Celebration of Dance:




Children in classes from Foundation to Year 5, together with the Year 5/6 Dance Club took part in a celebration of their PE work by performing their

Attendance:



As you are aware, Westcountry Schools Trust and Stowford School are keen to promote and support good attendance in school, in line with the Department for Education guidance document: 'Working together to improve school attendance'. The attendance target for pupils at Stowford School is 96%.

Schools are required to make parents/carers aware of their child's attendance, particularly when there is a drop in attendance, and schools must offer support to enable children to attend. Letters are regularly issued in order to keep parents/carers informed and to offer help if this would be of benefit.

At Stowford School attendance is often affected by holidays in term time. A reminder that holidays cannot be authorised unless for truly exceptional circumstances. Where unauthorised holidays are taken, this can lead to a penalty notice issued by Devon county Council.

Our whole school attendance figure is currently 95.7%.

Pupil Premium Free School Meals:

Please do speak to the office if you think that you may be eligible for benefit-related free school meals - or apply online via the Citizen Portal:

https://www.devon.gov.uk/supportforschools/service s-and-contacts/free-school-meals. It is worth registering if you are eligible as this attracts considerable extra funding for your child's education, even if your child does not actually have a school meal. Please also apply even if your child is in receipt of UIFSM, as the school will still receive additional funding which benefits your child and the school.

Free School Meal vouchers to cover the Easter holidays and HAF codes have been issued to our eligible families.

There are 4 types of volunteers for Stowford Friends Committee Member - You would like to be part of the committee; this involves attending the committee meetings that happen 3-6 times a year generally in the evening/ can be on TEAMs. It's no problem if you can only attend 1 or 2. You will be added to the WhatsApp group to help give ideas for fundraising and make decisions about how the committee spend the money raised. You are instrumental in the organisation of some of the events/activities the PTA offer but only required to help as and when you can.

Volunteer - You will be added to the volunteer list and help out on an event or two (events that involve the children you can bring your kids along to help out too if needed - they love running a stall!) the more volunteers we have the less time you need to help (1 hr slots) for an event. There is no set commitment just help out when you can, and you will be happy to be delegated admin work to do in front of the TV the odd night throughout the year.

Admin Volunteer - This is where you can't attend meetings or help at events due to childcare or work commitments, but you would be happy to help with jobs at home, making things, wrapping, leaflets, packing and sticking or you have a skill in something (like financial for example) and would be happy to look over the accounts once a year or offer a workshop.

Class Rep – You will liaise via the playground and/or solely on social medial (FB page) or WhatsApp any notifications about events and be a direct contact between PTA and parents. You may also gain feedback to help decide events and ideas on how to spend the money.

The more parents we can get to help out the less we all have to do and the more money we can raise to improve the facilities and environment our children have at school.
