

## Stowford School Standards Report 2018

### Foundation Stage

Children entered school broadly in line with standards expected for their age. By the end of the academic year 87% (70.7% National last year) had achieved a Good Level of Development.

### Phonics summary

88% of children in Year 1 passed the phonics screening (81% National 2017).

Year 2: 50% of the children who sat this assessment again reached the standard.

Year 2 children have undergone statutory testing against the new standard and this has been used to inform teacher assessment.
